EAR'S PAIN

Description:	Painful sensation, pulsatile or constant in the ear's region. Sudden or progressive beginning or deteriorating with certain activities. In the small child could be demonstrates as weeping and unpreparedness.
Is it an emergency?	Yes, since without opportune treatment can cause a perforation of the eardrum, which is very painful.
Test to be done :	The diagnosis is confirmed during the Medical Consultation, in which there is a systematic analysis of all the possible causes, including those that have direct relation with Nose and Paranasales sinus. The ear's examination with ear's endoscopy allows the visualizing of the auditory external canal and the eardrum, to locate the exact place of the pain's origin. Middle ear analysis is also done, etc
Procedure done in office:	Instrumental ear's aspiration . Any obstructive material will be evacuated. It is practised with or without local anaesthesia according to the age and the patient collaboration. There can be necessary more than one session of Instrumental aspiration and / or antibiotic's drop instill . Ear pop, Eustachian tube's mechanical patency, etc.
Procedure done in the operating room:	Myringocenthesis with radiofrequency with or without T-tube.
